

Painting A World War II U.S. Tanker with P3



This Young Miniatures World War II U.S. Tanker in 1/10 scale bust was painted with P3 paint.

WWII Tanker Jacket

Base color: Airbrush Rucksack Tan from the top down to get a base color for the jacket. Airbrush Umbral Umber from the bottom up to get the base shadows.

1st Highlight: Menoth White Base + Rucksack Tan

2nd Highlight: Menoth White Base

Additional Highlights: Add Menoth White Highlight to get subsequent highlights until you are using straight Menoth White Highlight in a very thin layer.

Shadows: Rucksack Tan + Gun Corps Brown

Subsequent Shadows: Gun Corps Brown

Darkest Shadows: Umbral Umber. You may also add a little bit of Thamar Black to get the deepest shadows.

Collar: Thornwood Green. Rucksack Tan/Menoth White Base for highlights. Battlefield Brown and Thamar Black for shadows.

WWII Tanker Helmet

Base color: Mix Thornwood Green + a little Ordic Olive + Thamar Black to get a dark military olive drab.

Shadows: Base + Thamar Black

Final Shadows: Add Armor Wash or very thin Thamar Black.

Highlights: Start with Traitor Green + Thornwood Green.

Additional Highlights: Traitor Green

Highest Highlights: Traitor Green + Rucksack Tan, ending with straight Rucksack Tan

Stitching: Menoth White Highlight

Leather Edging: Bootstrap Leather. Highlighting with Bootstrap Leather + Rucksack Tan or Beast Hide. Shadows with Battlefield Brown.

Shirt

Base: Traitor Green

Highlights: Traitor Green + Rucksack Tan. Menoth White Base for the high highlights.

Shadows: Battledress Green. Adding Battlefield Brown or Thamar Black to get darkest shadows.
